Food for Thought

- \$8000 in taxpayer dollars for mailing a single newsletter raises a fair question about scale and impact.

What does that look like per household?

Re: Administrator Update

In addition to items presented in the packet please see the following notes of interest:

- Matt Lein and I met with Jake and Meghan from Bolton and Menk for an update on the WWTP and to seek clarity on what a phosphorus monitoring system could do to help us. The Phosvax equipment (phosphorus monitoring system) has dropped in price and estimated at \$80,000 for the equipment and 1 year of service. It is a 4-6 week lead time to get the equipment and could be installed and operational with 2 weeks. Jake will be coming to a February meeting to discuss a proposal to go forward with the equipment. Additionally, The MN Public Facilities Authority (MNPFA) looks to be close to finalizing it's project list and we are optimistic to be in the fundable range but still waiting for the list to be finalized. Mayor Lein will provide more updates at the meeting.

- 111 John Ave S update – the redemption period for the sheriff sale has passed and ownership is now secured for Paul Modeen who has reached out to Cindy Nash to discuss options moving forward. Considering a multifamily unit – quadplex, but no firm plans as of yet
- Planning Commission met Wed Jan 7th reviewed ordinance revisions on Chapter 71 Parking Regulations and Chapter 151 Swimming Pools. Tentatively up next to review will be Chapter 73 – Recreational Vehicles and Chapter 74 – Bicycles (and other things with wheels)
- Submitted and received reimbursement of \$139,000 – final costs associated with the Water Tower Rehab project. Total Federal Grant Money received for the project was \$457,000.
- \$1,265,655 in Bond Payments were made this month – the balloon payment on the 2013 refinance was \$760,087 of that amount.
- Preliminary audit work is in full swing.
- Chief Vos and I have had several conversations this past week about how to move forward with the committee work on better understanding the SVF PERA Pension Plan. Hope to have our first committee meeting in late February
