2016 UTILITY ASSESSMENTS


WHEREAS, pursuant to notice duly given as required by law, the City Council has met, heard and passed upon all objections to the proposed assessment for 2016 Utility Assessments, and has amended such proposed assessment as it deems just;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cologne, Minnesota, as follows:


- 1) Such proposed assessment, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof is hereby accepted and shall constitute the special assessment against the lands named therein, and each tract of land therein is hereby found to be benefitted by the proposed utility.
- 2) Such assessments shall be as follows:
  - a. The assessments shall be payable in one annual installment to be payable with general taxes for the year 2016, collectible with such taxes during the year 2017.
  - b. To the first installment shall be added interest at the rate of 6.00 percent (6.00%) per annum on the entire principal amount of the assessment from the date of this resolution until December 31 of the year in which such installment is payable.

The City Clerk shall forthwith transmit a certified duplicate copy of this assessment to the County Auditor to be extended on the tax list of the County

Whereupon said resolution was declared duly passed and adopted.
